

CHECKLIST FOR TAX DOCUMENTS

1. Personal Information

- Copy of the previous tax return (if available)
- o Tax form 2024
- o Proof of civil status (e.g., marriage certificate, divorce decree)
- o Birthdates of children and other household members

2. Income Documents

- o Annual salary statements from employers
- Pension certificates (AHV, IV, pension fund, accident or sickness benefits)
- o Proof of secondary income (e.g., fees, part-time work, tips)
- Evidence of unemployment benefits (ALV)
- o Documents regarding alimony (received or paid)
- Certificates of foreign income (if applicable)

3. Asset Documents

- o Bank statements as of December 31 (all accounts, including savings and youth accounts)
- Securities account statements (including dividend statements)
- Proof of property ownership (e.g., taxable value, rental value, mortgage interest)
- Certificates of debts and loans (including interest statements)
- o Evidence of cash or cryptocurrencies
- Life insurance documents (surrender value)



4. Deductions (Professional and Personal)

- o Proof of professional expenses (e.g., commute, meals, work tools)
- Continuing education costs (invoices, proofs)
- Documents for childcare costs (daycare, nanny, after-school care)
- Receipts for maintenance payments (e.g., alimony)
- Proof of donations (donation receipts)
- Receipts for medical and accident expenses not covered by insurance
- o Proof of contributions to charitable organizations

5. Insurance and Pension

- o Certificates for the 3rd pillar (pillar 3a contributions)
- o Pension documents (pension fund, vested benefits accounts)
- o Insurance premiums (health, accident, and life insurance)

6. Homeownership

- Evidence of mortgage debts (including interest statements)
- o Taxable value and imputed rental value of the property
- Documents on renovation costs (if deductible)
- o Documents for property maintenance and ancillary costs

7. Additional Documents

- o Receipts for lottery winnings or other extraordinary income
- o Documents on inheritances or gifts
- Documents on capital gains or losses
- o Tax certificates for foreign accounts or investments



8. Special Life Situations

- Receipts for moving expenses (if job-related)
- Proof of stays abroad (e.g., work abroad)
- o Documents on family caregiving situations (e.g., care expenses)

9. Business Documents (for the Self-Employed)

- o Profit and loss statement and balance sheet
- o Receipts for business expenses
- o Documents for business rentals and investments
- VAT statements
